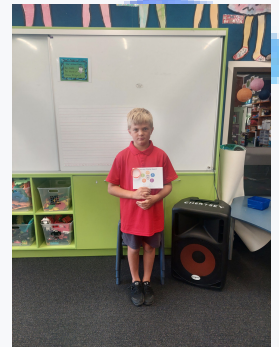
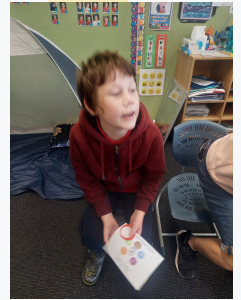
LET'S CELEBRATE
