



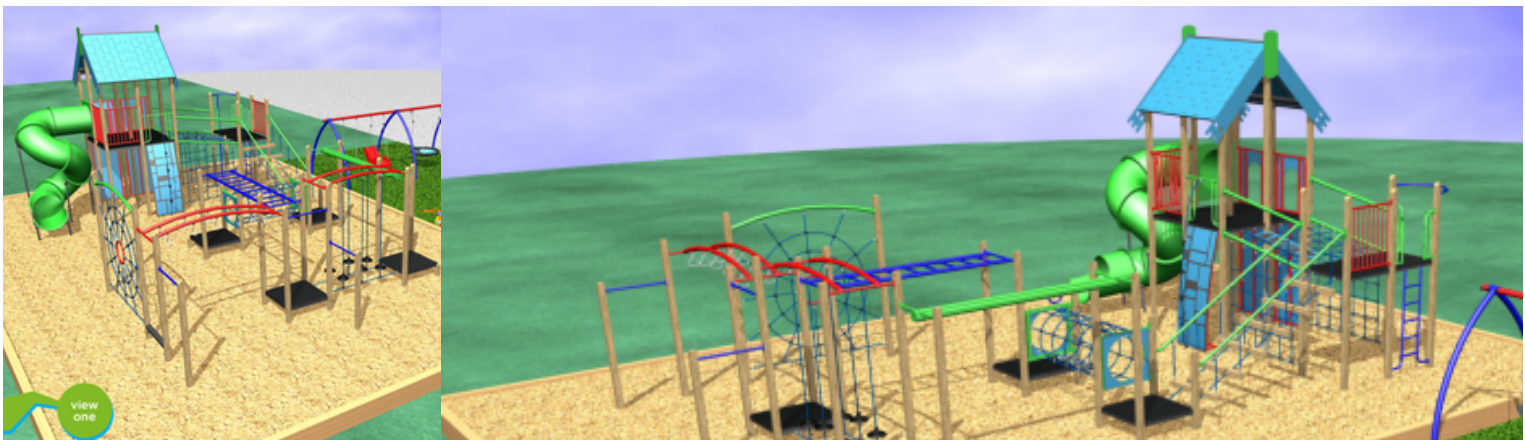

Kia Ora e te Whanau/Greetings Chertsey families,

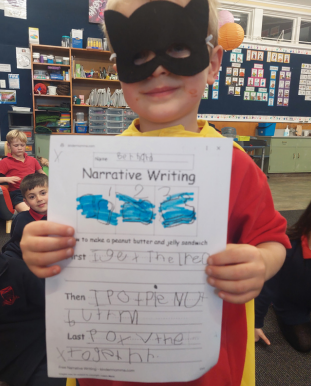

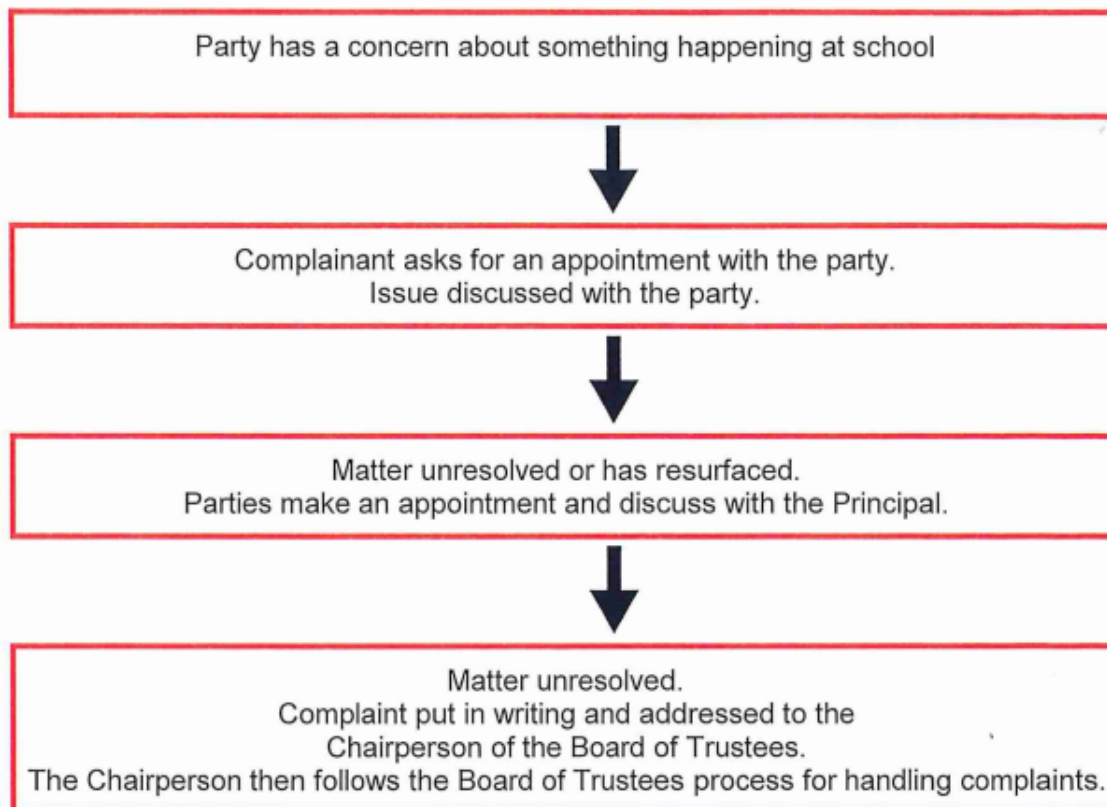


Dear parents/caregivers, here is a reminder of our complaints procedure.
