









ROOM 3 CAMP THANK YOU LETTERS

One amazing thing we did was Space Place. I liked the Planetarium. The videos about the stars and their pictures were interesting.


It was incredible because we went inside of the Beehive. We were lucky to be given permission to sit in the Chamber seats. Thank you James.






