Welcome

Hero

This year, we will be using Hero to communicate with parents/caregivers. We will also be publishing your child's reports on Hero. Please see instructions in this newsletter on how to access Hero. You will need to use your email address that is on record at our school.

Attendance

Once you are logged into the Hero App you will able to record your child's absence. This will notify staff and you wont need to call or message the school. If you do not have the App, please ensure you let our staff know before 8.55am. We ask that children have a justified reason for being absent. Kai for Kids

We continue to receive healthy lunches and snacks by our amazing Healthy Lunches provider Kai for Kids. The Kai for Kids team have done a lot of planning and research to ensure the food provided at school is healthy for our tamariki. We ask that you keep this in mind as you pack your child's morning tea. Our staff check daily and provide morning tea to any students who do not bring any from home.



Mornings

Please ensure that your child does not arrive at school before 8.30am. We love welcoming our students and families from 8.30am and invite you to engage with your child's teacher during this time. From 8.55am, we ask that all parents/caregivers leave so that our day of learning can begin. Most teachers are available after school but it pays to make an appointment to ensure we can make the time available to you. Our teachers have been very busy preparing for our school camp. Thank you to the parents who have volunteered to be helpers at camp. In the following weeks, you will receive our itinerary and activity list. You will also receive a medical form to fill in for your child.


