Exciting News for Our School & Community

Chertsey School is excited to share plans for our next big project — the creation of a brand new multi-sport court, soon to be known as the Agright Community Court. This space will provide high-quality facilities for basketball, netball, and pickleball, and will be available for both our tamariki during school time and the wider Chertsey community after hours. The new court will be built next to the playground, creating a vibrant hub of play and activity. It will feature adjustable hoops so our younger learners can enjoy the space just as much as our older students.

We are pleased to let you know that we have already secured strong support to help make this vision a reality. Agright has committed to sponsoring the project with \$5,000 each year for the next four years, with a strong chance that this partnership will continue beyond that. We have also received a \$10,000 grant from the Community Trust of Mid & South Canterbury as well as a generous personal donation of \$1,800 from Lynley and James Proctor.

Once we secure the remaining funding, we will be able to give this project the green light. **Our goal is to see the court completed during 2026.**

This is an exciting step forward for our school and community, and we look forward to keeping you updated as progress continues. You can see from the rendered design below just how fantastic this new facility will be.
